■ Caution

[Precautions for Use]

- Please read notes printed on the main body of the CompactFlash® card thoroughly.
- Use the CompactFlash card in an environment that meets the general specifications in the user's manual for the module used. Using the programmable controller in any other operating environments may cause electric shocks, fires or malfunctions, or may damage or degrade the module.
- Push the CompactFlash card into the CompactFlash card slot and install it securely. After installing the CompactFlash card, check that it is inserted securely. Failure to do so may cause malfunctions due to poor contact.
- When ejecting the CompactFlash card, support it by hand since it may pop out. Failure to do so may cause a fall of the CompactFlash card leading to failure or damage of the card.
- Never disassemble or modify the CompactFlash card. This may cause breakdowns, malfunctions, injuries or fire.
- Always make sure to touch the grounded metal to discharge the electricity charged in the body, etc., before touching the CompactFlash card. Failure to do so may cause a failure or malfunctions of the CompactFlash card.

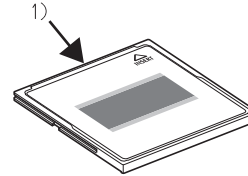
